FROM: Joanne K. Metzen, Director of Pupil Services **RE:** Open Enrollment for Pupils with Disabilities

Beginning in the 2019-20 school year, procedures for reimbursements and payments for the open enrollment of pupils with disabilities has changed. The standard estimated reimbursement for 2021-2022 is \$13,013 for open enrolled pupils with disabilities, as defined by IDEA and Wis. Stats. § 115.76 (5). This is the amount paid by the resident district for the first year to the non-resident, choice district, to cover the cost of educating the student. In subsequent years, if a student with disabilities continues to be open enrolled in the same non-resident, choice district, the non-resident district can charge the resident school district for costs of providing a Free Appropriate Public Education, FAPE for any costs in excess of the standard rate of approximately \$13,013, up to \$30,000. While the \$13,013 is \$4,852 over the open enrollment amount for regular education students (\$8,161), the cost for educating pupils with disabilities can vary substantially. Once a district approves an open enrollment request, they can be subject to substantial costs in future years owed to other districts, or charged to other districts for services provided. School boards are required to designate the number of special education spaces available for the next school year. Space determinations must be made and approved by the school board at its January board meeting.

Space availability in special education was determined by:

- 1. Documenting Projected Enrollment in each Program/Service
- 2. Determining the Suggested Enrollment for each program/service by utilizing a document provided by DPI with Statewide Caseload Suggestions
- 3. Determining the Working Capacity for the program/service which is 95% of the maximum suggested enrollment
- 4. Calculating the Open Enrollment Ceiling with the ceiling determined at 90% of working capacity for elementary and middle school school and district wide programs and 100% of the working capacity at the high school
- 5. Determining Space Available by comparing the Open Enrollment Ceiling to the Projected Enrollment looking specifically at the Teacher Student Ratio. If our projected enrollment is at, or higher than the Open Enrollment Ceiling, the program is closed.
